## AMENDMENT TO THE HARTSEL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER PENSION BYLAWS JANUARY 1, 2014

<u>Eligibility for Retirement Benefits:</u> In order to be eligible for retirement benefits the volunteer firefighter must maintain a minimum of thirty-six (36) hours per year of training participation. In addition to the required yearly training hours a volunteer must be "on scene" at a minimum of ten percent (10%) of the calls responded to by the Department in that year. OR the volunteer firefighter must complete 8 days of on-call weekend rotation duty in that year.
The above must be completed by the volunteer firefighter for each year of pension service awarded beginning in the year 2014.
