## "POSTED" ADDRESS REQUIREMENTS

Park County Land Use Regulation Section 7-1207 Address Number Signage

Park County requires properties undergoing development to have a permanent address posted. This address post is permanent and is not just for the inspector but is for the use of the Fire Department, Sheriff and Emergency Services. The street address numbers need to be posted on the property <u>prior</u> to the preliminary inspection of the driveway.

- Placard shall be attached to a 4" X 4" treated wood or redwood post.
- The post shall be placed at the driveway no further than 5 feet from the property line. Note:
  The post must not be placed in the county road right-of-way.
- The top of the post shall be installed, in a permanent fashion, a minimum of 48 inches above the ground. If the ground is frozen, place the post in a 5 gallon bucket filled with sand or rock until the post must be permanently installed into the ground for final inspection.
