This Burn Permit is issued to allow open burning pursuant to Section 1102 of the 1994 Uniform Fire Code, which shall apply and restrict such burning except as modified below.

1. PRIOR TO STARTING THE BURN, call the Park County Communications Office at 836-4160. The dispatcher will know if a Fire Ban is in effect that would prohibit open fires. **2. All controlled burns must be reported to Hartsel Fire Protection District at 836-3500.** If there is no answer at Hartsel Fire please leave a message as to the day, time, permit number and location of your burn. **You Must call Hartsel Fire Protection District to report your controlled burn.**

2. All open fires, including controlled burns allowed by this burn permit are PROHIBITED if dry or windy conditions exist, when a FIRE BAN is in effect, or if the Fire Chief or Fire Marshall determines that smoke emissions are offensive to occupants of surrounding property, or if open burning is determined to constitute a hazardous condition due to fuel, weather or other conditions affecting fire spread.

3. The burn site must be located at least 50 ft. from any structure or combustible material (trees, shrubs, wood piles etc).

4. The burn site must be clear of all combustible material to mineral soil & have a minimum of 10 ft. of cleared space.

5. It is recommended that all burns be contained in a steel barrel with a screened top.

6. The burn must be smaller than 1 cubic yard (3 x 3 x 3) of material at a residential location. Commercial locations may burn 3 cubic yards at a time.

7. Flying brands (embers, debris) and cinders must be confined within the 10 foot area cleared of all combustible materials to mineral soil.

8. Building contractors must have a separate permit for each location.

9. This burn permit is valid for the applicant at the address listed above only.

10. The burn must not include hazardous materials or materials that emit harmful vapor or smoke.

11. The Fire Department must be allowed access to the burn site at all times during the burn and following the burn to confirm proper extinguishment.

12. An adequate continuous water supply and/or fire extinguishers and other fire fighting tools, (i.e., shovel, hoe, rake) must be readily available at all times during the burn in case of emergency.

13. The burn must be attended by a competent person at all times.

14. No Burning of Marijuana by-products, (stocks, fertilizer, etc.)

*******NEVER LEAVE A FIRE UNATTENDED!*******

This permit is good only for the address listed above and is not transferable or assignable. The conditions stated herein are binding on the undersigned, the property owner and any other person conducting burning at such property pursuant to this permit. The undersigned, the property owner and any other person conducting burning pursuant to this permit agree to meet the requirements set forth in this permit to burn. **This permit will be revoked if any of the conditions stated above are not met.** Fines and/or costs of extinguishment will be assessed to the person conducting the burning, the applicant and the property owner for failure to comply with these conditions.
