# **Burn Permit Account Setup Instructions**




Log into <a href="https://hfpd.burnpermits.com/login">https://hfpd.burnpermits.com/login</a>, if you are new the site you will need to create a user account, if you are returning, simply log in with your user name and password.



### **Create Account:**

To create an account, click "Create Account", your next prompt will be to enter your email address, then click "OK"




### **Personal Information:**

Enter your name and phone number into the appropriate fields.




Renters: You will need to provide information for your property Landlord and/or the homeowner on record. This request will require approval by Landlord and/or the homeowner before permit can be issued.




Enter your property address you intend to have a fire/burn.

Login Details: Your email will be your username, simply add your password to have return access to your permit account. When completed click "Continue".



### **Confirm Your Location:**

The next screen will ask you to confirm you address location on our map, the marker symbol will represent your mapped location, if it is mapped incorrectly just click-and-drag the marker to place it in the correct location. When correct click "Continue".

\*The burn site must be located at least 50 ft. from any structure or combustible material (trees, shrubs, wood piles, etc.)

\*The burn site must be clear of all combustible material to mineral soil & have a minimum of 10 ft. of cleared space.

\* Flying embers, brands, and cinders must be confined or contained to the cleared space within the approved area.

 $"Burns \ must be \ attended \ at \ all \ times \ by \ a \ competent, responsible \ individual \ until \ the \ burn \ is \ completely \ out/cold.$ 


\*An adequate water supply, fire extinguisher, and firefighting tools (shovels, rake etc.) must be available on site.








# Pay with PayPal
